- Brian discussed the Toledo Weak Signals Show. Brian mentioned that he felt the AMA was poorly represented considering that this show is the largest in the midwest area and only a short distance from AMA Headquarters.
- May meeting date, time, and location was set for May 21st at 6:00 pm at the club field. Our annual spring work detail was set for May 25th at 10:00 am. General field cleanup, repairs, etc.
- Al discussed his feelings with regard to the direction of the club. Several other members added their input as well with the general consensus being that we should focus on flying and put less focus on community events.
- Discussion about the budget issue that was brought up in the email exchange. Milo made a motion for the record that a budget isn't needed and should not be considered, Al seconded the motion. Motion carried.
- Ballots were passed out and voting took place for the amendment to our club bylaws. We required 2/3 of the membership or 16 votes to pass. The final vote count was 15 yes votes and 0 no votes, the amendment failed to pass.
- John made a motion that we reconsider the amendment at our May meeting, seconded by Jim, motion carried.
